School Finance for Businesses

The worst recession in 70 years is behind us, but the future is still daunting. Not only are school operations and facility funding continuing to force severe challenges on schools, there will be a new Governor with new issues and priorities. The 2011-12 state budget for schools still will be constrained by the drop-off of \$6 billion in temporary tax revenues that were enacted in 2009. While strong state economic growth would generate major positive state revenue gains, even after accounting for ending temporary taxes, strong growth is not expected. School funding will improve, but the amount of improvement could be mild, moderate, or good depending on the strength and speed of the state's economic recovery.

- Will January bring new funding for 2010-11 and 2011-12 or will it be the same?
- When will new federal funding be available for schools?
- What is next for school facilities?

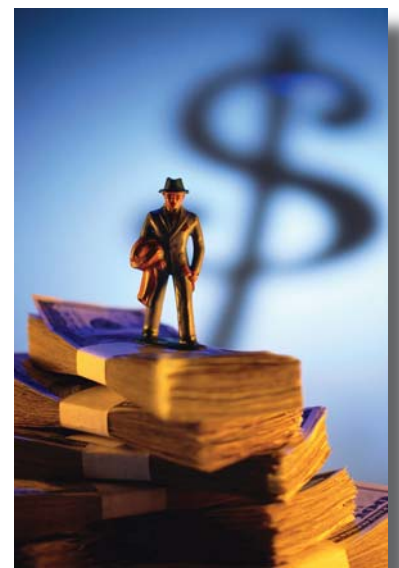
